It is my pleasure to announce the speaker for our November meeting of the Philadelphia Orthopaedic Society, L. Scott Levin, M.D. Dr. Levin is the Paul B. Magnuson Professor of Bone and Joint Surgery and the Chair of the Department of Orthopaedic Surgery at the University of Pennsylvania. He also serves as the Vice President and Associate Dean for Resource Development at Penn Medicine. Dr. Levin is Board-certified in both Orthopaedic Surgery and Plastic Surgery. His expertise focuses on surgery of the hand and upper extremity, reconstructive microsurgical

techniques for extremity reconstruction, and limb salvage. In 2022 he was awarded the Kappa Delta Elizabeth Winston Lanier Award from the AAOS for his research in extremity soft tissue reconstruction and vascularized composite allotransplantation. On Monday, November 13, he'll speak to us about his experience over the last 3 decades building the Vascularized Composite Allotransplantation Program at Penn and the Pediatric Hand Transplantation Program at Children's Hospital of Philadelphia. I look forward to seeing you at his talk, titled "Orthoplastic Extremity Reconstruction—33 Years of Progress."


