I want to invite you to our upcoming meeting, graciously endowed by the esteemed Dr. Parviz Kambin. On Monday, April 8th, we will remember him and celebrate his enduring legacy.

Dr. Kambin was a Professor of Orthopaedic Surgery and established an Endowed Chair of Spinal Surgery at Drexel University, College of Medicine. He was recognized by the College of Physicians of Philadelphia and artifacts of his work have been exhibited in the Mutter Museum. Dr. Kambin was instrumental in the establishment of the International Society for Minimal Intervention in Spinal Surgery in 1988. He was elected the first president of the society in 1990. He coined the term "minimally invasive spinal surgery" and is credited in the Dorland's Medical Dictionary with describing the "Kambin triangular working zone"

In addition to Dr. Kambin's academic endeavours, he was an integral part of the Philadelphia medical community. His commitment to advancing orthopaedic care touched the lives of countless patients in the region, earning him a place of honour among Philadelphia's medical luminaries.

It is my pleasure to announce our speaker for the 16th Annual Parviz Kambin Lecture, Dr. Han Jo Kim.

Dr. Kim is an attending spine surgeon and Professor of Orthopaedic Surgery at the Hospital for Special Surgery in New York City. He completed his orthopaedic training at HSS, at which point he moved on to his spine fellowship at Barnes-Jewish Hospital at Washington University in St Louis. He is particularly interested in cervical spine, deformity, and scoliosis surgery, and has also spent time overseas delivering orthopaedic care in the

developing world. Dr. Kim was selected for the Scoliosis Research Society Travelling Fellowship in 2017, and has published over 200 peer-reviewed articles as well as co-authored a cervical spine textbook.

As the director of the spine fellowship at HSS, Dr. Kim has a passion for education, as well as driving academic medicine forward. He will be speaking to the Society on the optimization of efficiency, safety, and resource utilization in spine surgery that may allow many procedures to be performed in the ambulatory setting.

This will be a unique and thought-provoking talk that can be applied to all subspecialties of orthopaedics, and I look forward to seeing you there!

#### The Eleanor A. Slanga Resident Research Award

The Eleanor A. Slanga Resident Research Award, was established to recognize excellence in research in the discipline of Orthopaedics. The award is open to all current Orthopaedic residents in programs associated with the Philadelphia Orthopaedic Society. **Original manuscripts not published prior to April 1, 2024 will be accepted for review.** 

The resident must be the first author, but not necessarily the only author of the paper. It is expected that the resident will have primary responsibility for the literature review, implementation of the study and final drafting of the discussion section.

The award and stipend (\$500.00) will be conferred at the Annual Resident Bowl on Monday, May 13, 2024.

Abstracts must be received no later than April 1, 2024 to allow adequate time for review. Any abstracts received after April 1, 2024 will be ineligible for consideration.


